

Lawrence J. Frisch

Heart Attack Victim

Died Soon After Admission
to Hospital

Lawrence J. Frisch, 45, of Thompson township, died shortly after he was admitted to Bellevue hospital at 11:45 a. m. Monday, March 2, 1959. He was stricken by a heart attack in the barn at his home Monday but was able to walk to the house where an ambulance was called to take him to the hospital.

Born near Bellevue Sept. 14, 1913, Mr. Frisch was a son of Frank and Catherine (Schreiner) Frisch. He was married Dec. 13, 1958, in Norwalk to Margie Parks, and is survived by his wife, his mother, Mrs. Catherine Frisch, of Milan; eight sisters, Mrs. Carl Alt, Reed township; Mrs. John Guloski and Mrs. Leon Moyer, of Bellevue; Mrs. Anthony Stockmaster and Mrs. Sylvester Stockmaster, both of New Washington; Mrs. Walter Claus, Attica; Mrs. Richard Meyers, Milan; Mrs. Eldred Heyman, Monroeville; and two brothers, Leo J.
